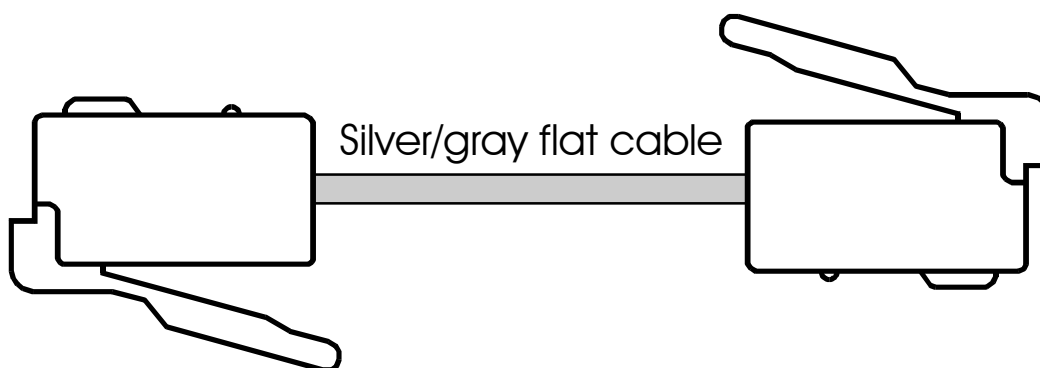


'Straight' cable with Modular connectors.

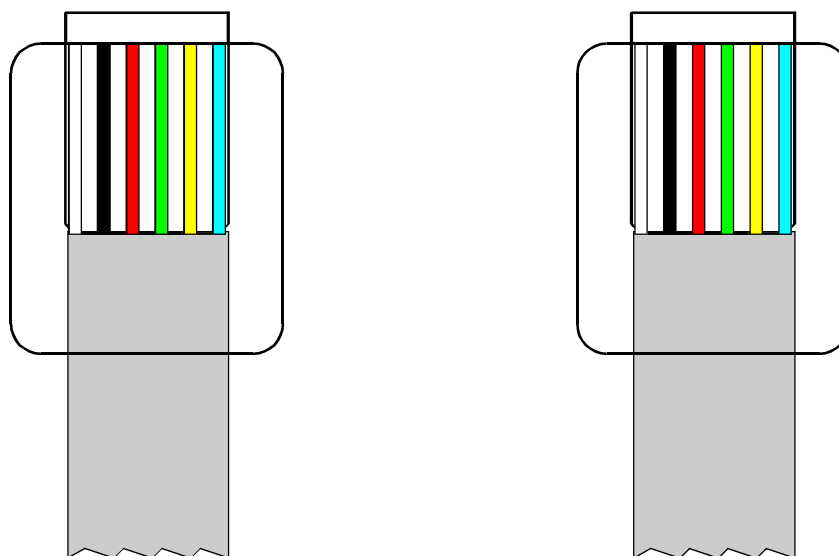
The contacts on Modular plugs and jacks are numbered.

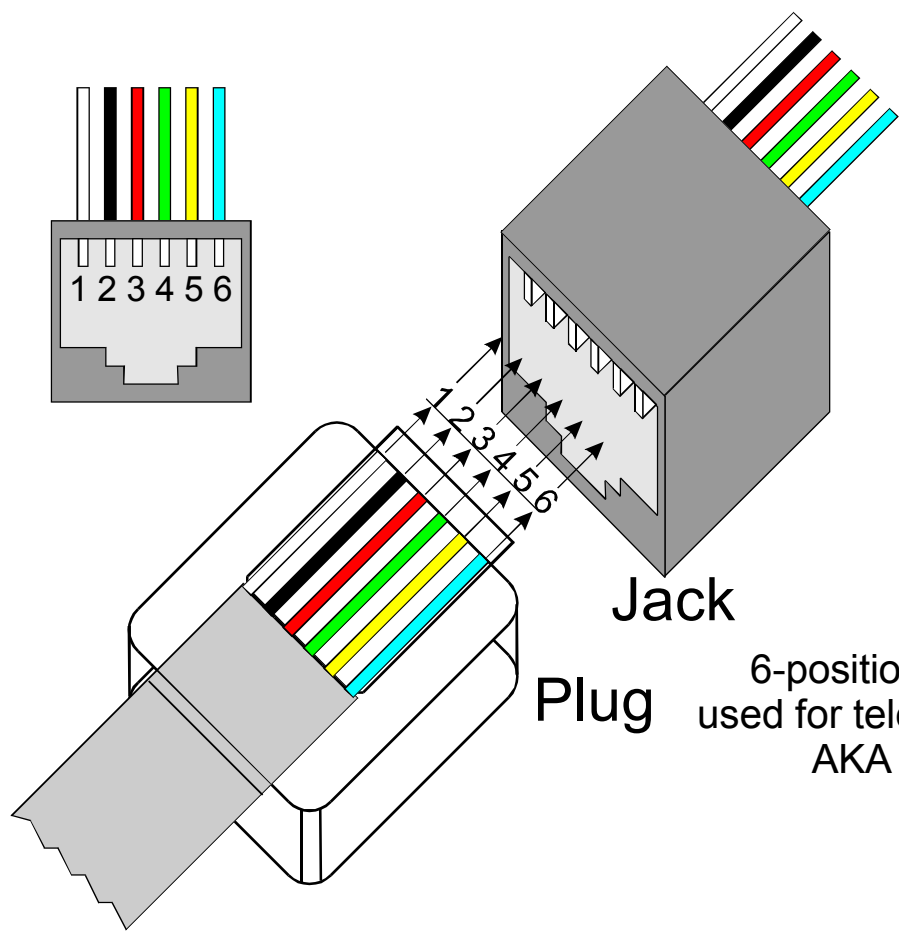
A 'straight' cable is one that has contact #1 on a plug wired to contact #1 on the plug on the other end. When wired this way, contact #1 on the Jacks on both ends will be connected to each other when you plug the cable in..

Side view of cable



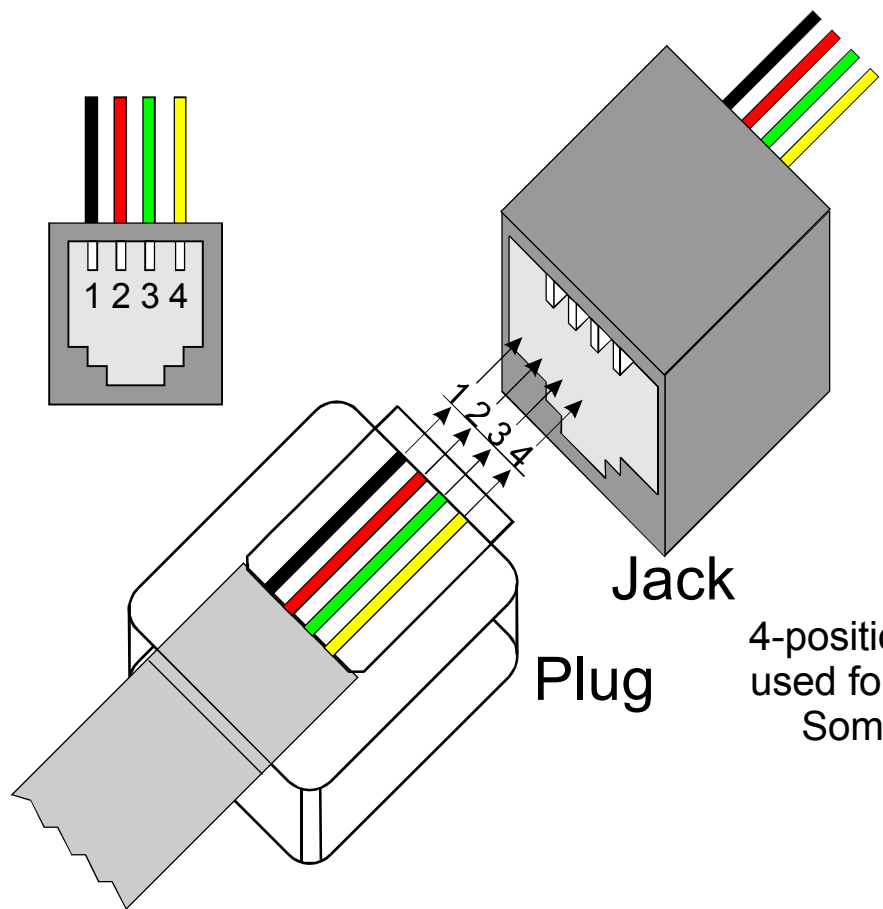
Ends of cable with the tab away from you.
